



### Degree Completion Timelines

**Degree Completion Timelines:** The MFT program is designed for full-time students to be completed in two and a half years for the MFT licensure track 1, two and a half years for the LPCC clinical track, and the non-clinical track can be completed in as little as 18 months. The maximum amount of years that students can take to complete the program is 5 years, regardless of if they attend on a full-time or part-time basis. For additional information that may impact time to degree completion, please see leave of absence section in handbook.

The Master of Arts (MA) in Marriage and Family Therapy (MFT) degree program at Touro University Worldwide (TUW) has three tracks:

1. Clinical-Track: The only track accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy Education (COAMFTE).
2. **Licensed Professional Clinical Counseling (LPCC) Track:** Approved by the [California Board of Behavioral Sciences \(BBS\)](#), not accredited by COAMFTE.
3. Non-Clinical Track: online MFT coursework; not accredited by COAMFTE.
